CB Nuit theme 2024: ~SPIRAL~

Project Proposals are now being accepted for CB Nuit 2024 Festival

**Deadline: June 15th, 2024**

CB Nuit is a magical and inspiring art festival in Ktaqamkuk / Newfoundland, nestled on the shore of Elmastukwek / Bay of Islands. On this shore, you will find Corner Brook, a small community with a beautiful and unique creative spirit. CB Nuit acknowledges that the land on which we gather, create, and celebrate creativity and community is in traditional Mi'kmaq territory. We respect the diverse histories and cultures of the Indigenous people of this province, including the Beothuk, the Mi'kmaq, Innu, and Inuit.

Since 2017, CB Nuit has taken place in the hustle and bustle of Corner Brook's downtown-West Street. The busy street shuts down for festival night, allowing large pedestrian audiences the opportunity to gather, experience art; and for community members to see their home in this new capacity. As festival goers wander through the area, they encounter the *heart* of CB Nuit, where numerous site-specific projects are installed at local businesses, as well as public indoor and outdoor spaces. Now in 2024, the festival has evolved into a large-scale multidisciplinary art event, and has represented hundreds of artists and musicians along the way.

### **THEME**

Our 2024 festival will be guided by the theme: ~SPIRAL~ inviting inward and outward journeys for artists to explore. ~SPIRAL~ provides the flexibility to invite a more personal exploration as well as a lighter more universal exploration; one that can be taken literally or metaphorically.

### **ARTIST FEES**

Successful applicants will receive:

- **Artist Fee (Lead Artist): \$750**

- Collectives are invited to add additional collaborators within their proposed budget (#8 in submissions guidelines) with an **additional fee of \$250 per additional Collaborator**

- **Installation Fee: \$250.00**

- The installation fee is for the artist to secure installation of their work (whether they

hire someone to install it or they do it themselves)

- **Workshop Facilitator Fee: \$400**

The applicant is asked to create a single PDF document that includes the following:

1. Applicant(s) or collective name and pronouns
2. Email address
3. Website and social media handles (optional)
4. Artist bio(s) (max 150 words)
5. Title of project
6. Project and/or Workshop Description (max 500 words)
7. Technical Requirements and installation details
8. Detailed Project Budget and/or Workshop Budget (see **BUDGET** section for details)
9. Up to 10 jpg images of support materials attached in your PDF. Please include descriptions to accompany your images (name, materials, dimensions, etc)
10. If you are attaching links to video or time-based work, please embed link in your submission PDF

## **BUDGET**

- **Project Budget:**

- Project budgets can include expenses such as materials, equipment rentals, collaborators fee (maximum \$250 per additional artist) or subcontracting/assistant fees)

- \* Approximately 75% of our projects with budgets of up to \$1,000 will be produced

- \* Approximately 25% of projects with budgets of up to \$3,000 will be produced

**\*Material expense receipts will be required for budget remunerations**

- **Workshop Budget:**

- Workshop budgets of up to \$500 can be submitted (#8 in submissions guidelines) (material expense receipts will be required for budget remunerations)

**FESTIVAL PRIORITIES:**

- We invite artists and makers from all disciplines
- We welcome established and emerging artists, or new applicants to apply regardless of their experience
- We encourage applicants to propose projects that are community-focused and participatory in nature
- We invite artists to experiment and explore unconventional spaces
- We welcome collaborative and collective/group projects
- We encourage creators to keep sustainability in mind (low carbon footprint)
- We encourage and give priority to local talent including all of the communities of Corner Brook and surrounding area
- CB Nuit recognizes the importance of equity and diversity and inclusivity.
- Please indicate any accessibility needs you may have and we will do our best to support you.
