



Calling All Artists! **CB Nuit's Fusion Residency Program**

Big ideas. Bold collaborations. One unforgettable night!

At CB Nuit, we believe art shines brightest when we come together as a community. That's why we created the Artist Fusion Residency—a program that brings artists from different disciplines together to share skills, spark ideas, and collaborate on something larger than any one of us could make alone.

We're inviting groups of 3–4 artists from different disciplines to apply and collaborate on a large-scale immersive project suitable for Art at Night Festivals. This residency is about connection, experimentation, and creating something unforgettable with and for our community.

What's in it for you?

- **3 day planning session** facilitated by CB Nuit staff, including mentorship introductions and planning and logistics for residency
- **3 weeks in Corner Brook** with creation space + mentorship (Spring 2026)
- **Premiering your work at CB Nuit 2026** — our 10th anniversary - separate CARFAC presentation for presenting at the festival!
- Opportunities to tour **Atlantic Canada & NL Historic Sites in 2027 pending funding.**
- **\$7,000 artist collective fee (3 person group)** + (material and equipment rental budget up to \$2,000) or **\$8,100 artist collective fee (4 person group)** + (material and equipment rental budget up to \$2,000)

Statement of Priority

In line with our commitment to community, representation, and sustainability, priority will be given to artists living on the West Coast of Ktaqmkuk (Newfoundland) as well as self-identified Indigenous artists. At CB Nuit, we celebrate art that inspires, we also care deeply about how it's made. Selected projects will demonstrate thoughtfulness in process, prioritizing the health of our community and the planet. Creativity and sustainability go hand in hand, ensuring that every work encourages responsible practices and leaves a positive social and environmental impact.
