

Call for Music Submissions CB Nuit theme 2024:~SPIRAL~ Music Set Proposals are now being accepted for CB Nuit 2024 Festival Deadline June 15th, 2024

CB Nuit is a magical and inspiring art festival in Ktaqamkuk / Newfoundland, nestled on the shore of Elmastukwek / Bay of Islands. On this shore, you will find Corner Brook, a small community with a beautiful and unique creative spirit. CB Nuit acknowledges that the land on which we gather, create, and celebrate creativity and community is in traditional Mi'kmaw territory. We respect the diverse histories and cultures of the Indigenous people of this province, including the Beothuk, the Mi'kmaq, Innu, and Inuit.

Since 2017, CB Nuit has taken place in the hustle and bustle of Corner Brook's downtown-West Street. The busy street shuts down for festival night, allowing large pedestrian audiences the opportunity to gather, experience art; and for community members to see their home in this new capacity. As festival goers wander through the area, they encounter the *heart* of CB Nuit, where numerous site-specific projects and music acts are presented at local businesses, as well as public indoor and outdoor spaces. Now in its 8th year, the festival has evolved into a large-scale multidisciplinary art event, and has represented hundreds of artists and musicians along the way.

FESTIVAL DATE

September 21, 2024 Festival weekend September 20-22, 2024

THEME

Our 2024 festival will be guided by the theme: ~SPIRAL~ inviting inward and outward journeys for artists to explore. ~SPIRAL~ provides the flexibility to invite a more personal exploration as well as a lighter more universal exploration; one that can be taken literally or metaphorically.

BAND FEES

Our standard fee for music groups is **\$200.00 per band member up to \$800.00 for the band**.

• Optional Workshop Facilitator Fee: \$400 (include a budget for materials if applicable) *Material expense receipts will be required for budget remunerations

The applicant is asked to create a single PDF document that includes the following:

- 1. Applicant(s) or band name and pronouns
- 2. Email address and physical location
- 3. Website and social media handles (optional)
- 4. Artist bio(s) (max 150 words)
- 5. Workshop Description, (if applicable) (max 500 words)
- 6. Technical Requirements and stage plot
- 8. Up to 5 jpg images of support materials including a band photo attached in your PDF.
- 9. A link to video or live performance (link embedded in the PDF)
- 10. If there is anything else you would like to add to your application, we would love to hear!

FESTIVAL PRIORITIES:

- We welcome established and emerging artists, or new applicants to apply regardless of their experience
- We encourage applicants to propose a music set that is community-focused
- We invite artists to experiment and explore unconventional spaces
- We encourage artists to keep sustainability in mind (low carbon footprint)
- We encourage and give priority to local talent including all of the communities of Corner Brook and surrounding area
- CB Nuit recognizes the importance of equity and diversity and inclusivity.
- Please indicate any accessibility needs you may have and we will do our best to support you.
